


The Kin Kin ride will be on 9th August, please let Bob know if you are going to attend, for catering purposes. We are unable to take panels this year so please take your own electric fencing or hobbles etc. Lorraine has booked a table for Friday night at the Kin Kin Hotel. The ride is on Saturday 9th August. We will be going up on the Friday.

Kin Kin is approximately 160 klms from Dayboro. Take the Pomona turn off on to Pomona Connection Road; it is approx. 20klms from there.

There are camping facilities at the sportsground with showers and toilets. It is behind the Kin Kin Hotel. There are 7 horse yards but you would have to be there early to get these. I advise that you take electric fencing.

There are meals available at the hotel. I have booked a table for dinner on Friday night. Breakfast and lunch is also available.

The ride commences at 8am and finishes around [4pm](#). It is a very scenic ride mostly along parts of the Noosa trail network. There are water troughs along the way. The ride is similar in terrain to our rides. You and your horse would need a moderate level of fitness.

There is no charge for the ride. You pay for your lunch, which is about \$5.00 for a steak sandwich or hamburger, plus drinks.

On the Saturday night you can buy dinner at the sportsground, which is very reasonable. There is also a band and dancing.
