


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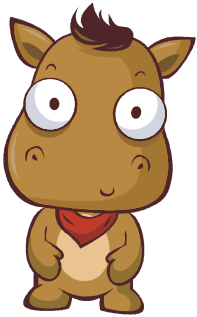

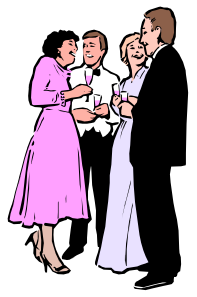
The BBQ lunch was again most enjoyable, along with the usual chit chat to end another good day horse riding.

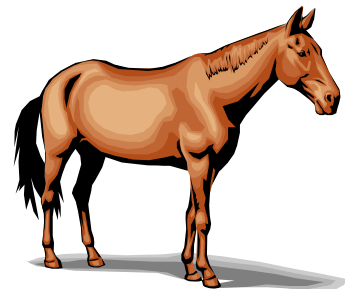
